
WHY HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS

- Human trafficking is modern day slavery.
- Unlike a drug that is a one-time sale, humans can be sold and resold, again and again.
- Human trafficking profits \$150 billion a year, second only to drug trafficking.
- Traffickers target areas of concentrated male populations.



TRAINING EMPLOYEES IN THE ENERGY INDUSTRY

- PPL's Human Trafficking Awareness Program integrates a five-step process to train employees on the red flags
 of human trafficking and gives them the tools to report this crime.
- We empower our team to be the eyes and ears on the road.
- Training our own workforce and inspiring others to do the same, we can all work together to stop human trafficking.



HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS TRAINING PROGRAM

- At field locations training begins at every orientation and for the home office, at onboarding.
- Training uses video, materials and visual reminders at sites.
- Education continues throughout projects and at the home office.

- The second largest and fastest growing criminal industry in the world today, second only to the drug trade.
- Unlike a drug that is a one-time sale, humans can be sold and resold, again and again.

Traffickers target victims they don't know

FACT

Many survivors have been trafficked by romantic partners, and by family members, including parents.

MYTH

White passenger vans or commercial vans with external locks are a sign of trafficking.

FACT

Traffickers drive all kinds of vehicles. There is no evidence that they favor white vans.

The use of force, fraud and/or coercion to prey upon victims' vulnerabilities while profiting off their exploitation.

SEX TRAFFICKING

another individual to sell sex.

LABOR TRAFFICKING

Use of force, fraud or coercion to manipulate Use of force, fraud or coercion to manipulate another individual to work or provide service.

 Observe existing training and policies to see where program training can be added with minimal disruption to the current procedures and workflow.







HTA PROGRAM: TRAINING & CONTINUING EDUCATION


- Inform current employees of the program and encourage them to participate.

HTA COMPANY POLICY No Demand, No Trafficking.



Purpose: To maintain a work environment that is free from human trafficking and slavery. Any violation of human rights in which the victims are deprived of their fundamental freedoms will not be tolerated.

This includes acquisition of a human being through the use of force, fraud or coercion, or in which the person is induced to perform such act has not attained 18 years of age, for the purpose of exploiting the individual, adult or child, for profit through forced labor, prostitution or both.




